SAFETY TIPS FOR CHILDREN TO BE RESPONSIBLE ONLINE:

- Understand the age appropriateness of platforms you use
- Follow privacy guidelines of social media and gaming platforms
- Select online games by checking their rating and content on www.pegi.info or www.esrb.org
- Avoid downloading games / material from unknown or unverified sources
- Learn to identify bullying content on gaming or social media platforms, and aggressively report cyber-bullying
- It is NOT COOL to boast about playing illegal games or accepting challenges, to draw attention
- Do not spread rumours, they cause more panic and harm
- Learn self-control, plan and minimise screen-time
- Never share personal details like name, address, date of birth, contact details etc. online
- Be kind with words, Memes, videos and the content you post
- Raise your voice against any objectionable content. You have the power to say "NO" to what you feel uncomfortable with
- No person / game / activity online should make you feel scared,

- threatened, fearful, ashamed, confused
- When you are asked not to disclose an objectionable incident to adults, YOU MUST share it with your parents or teacher
- Social media is legal for age 13+ only
- Hacking others accounts / WiFi,
 Creating Fake Accounts are cybercrimes
- Stalking somebody online with an intention of harassment is a cybercrime
- Using tools to Morph images and video with an intention of harassment is a cyber-crime
- Asking for or sharing any objectionable / inappropriate pictures / videos (nudes / seminudes) with anybody is a severe cyber-crime
- If you find your friend facing signs of danger or threats online, DO NOT be a bystander, support them.
 Stop, Block and Report the abuse!

Do not attempt self-harm, your life is valuable, you are loved by your parents for the way you are. Reach out to a trusted adult or a counsellor, talk about your feelings

GAMING RULES & GUIDELINES

- Do not link banking cards, avoid playing with money
- Do not make in-game purchases without parent's consent
- Read game rules before engaging in the game
- Do not get pressurised by threats and tempted by in-game offers
- Verify whom you connect with on Discord

- Don't share Discord link with strangers on social media
- Play multi-players games with people you know in real, not with strangers

TECHNICAL TIPS:

- Follow privacy settings for every App, social media profile and control stranger access
- Use kiddle.com and YouTubeKids as your default browsers, if you are under 12 years
- Use different complex passwords for each online account and change it regularly
- Use licensed updated anti-virus software
- Avoid accessing social media or banking accounts from unknown

- devices or free Wi-Fi
- Remember to logout of your online accounts, turn off Wi-Fi, Bluetooth and GPS, when not in use
- URLs with an "https" are always secure, verify URLs
- Install minimum essentials Apps on your devices, read their T&C before installing
- Do not allow someone else to access and operate your online account
